### *Giving Hope to Eva*

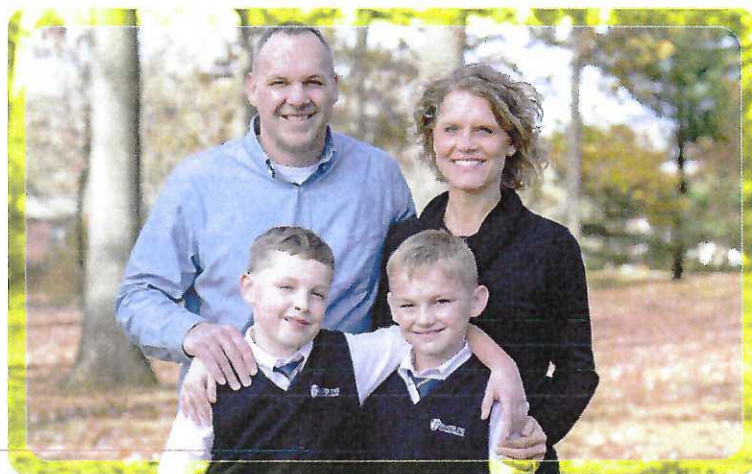
