In 1999 Caritas Ukraine became a full member of Caritas Internationalis and Caritas Europe, collaborating with Caritas members such as Caritas Switzerland, Caritas Belgium, Caritas Italy, Caritas France, Caritas Austria, Caritas Germany and Caritas Spain.
